

Drop the Charges

Maxwell Nemadzivhanani, the chief representative of the PAC in Australia, and his partner and wife. Kerry Browning, were charged by the Australian Federal police in relation to the firebombings of South African and American diplomatic cars.

Stop the police frame-up

Maxwell and Kerry are innocent of these charges. The PAC does not engage in firebombings, which serve no political, let alone military purpose. The only people who benefit from such an attack are the South African government.

Close the racist embassy
