Can be be overpowered and assaulted by these girls? The blame for the seduction of girls and the spread of disease must be placed where it belongs and that is on the shoulders of the men concerned. Any man found in bed or in compromising circumstances with a young girls should be detained and persecuted. It is time the facts were faced. It must be recognized cortain number of pen are debauchers and perverts. While wen are at large they will continue to seduce and debauch irls and to poison and destroy the springs of Australia's They are a greater danger in our midst than a small-pex set or a forger, or a thief, or a mirderer. They must be yed from society. It is the only way.

We doubt they are often silly ignorant - but they are not bad and they are not diseased if they have been seduced and infected by some man.
