The People's Parliamentary Platform, 1890

- 1. Universal White Adult Suffrage for all parliamentary and local elections; no plural voting; no nominee or property qualification chamber.
- 2. State registration of all citizens as electors.
- 3. Provision for full and complete enfranchisement of the floating population.
- 4. All parliamentary election on one day, and that day a close holiday, and all public-houses closed.
- 5. Equal electoral districts on adult population basis. 6. Annual parliaments.
- 6. Abolition of veto.
