



## WHY DO SOME WOMEN WOR

AND

#### WHAT DO THEY DO WI'THEIR EARNINGS:

The answer was given in a survey made by the Wom Bureau of the American Labor Office.

#### A QUESTIONNAIRE to 9.000 Unic members disclosed that . . .

- · Two-thirds were using all or most of their earning support themselves and their dependants.
- Nearly two-thirds fully or partly supported at least other person.
- Nine-tenths had no income other than their earnings
- Nearly 23 per cent. of single women were the sole sup. of the families.
- Nearly 46 per cent. of widows had no other means support,
- Nearly 78 per cent, used all they earned for food, cle ing, rent and medical care for themselves and the

#### The Survey Showed

That married women, to a greater extent than six women, used their earnings for current support of themsel and families, and the proportion increased from 20 ve to 50 years and often over 60 years of age.
